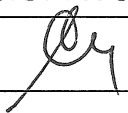
RESOLUTION NO. 10 OF 1998

1. Noting that Section 37 (1) of the Labour Relations Act, No. 66 of 1995 (the LRA) states that the Public Service Co-ordinating Bargaining Council (PSCBC) may designate a sector of the public service for the establishment of a bargaining council;
2. The parties to the PSCBC hereby resolve to designate the general administrative sector for the establishment of a bargaining council.
3. The parties agree further that the scope of the General Administrative Sector Bargaining Council is as follows:
4. General administrative sector means the State, as employer and its employees who do not fall within the registered scope of the :
 - (a) the Education Labour Relations Council;
 - (b) the National Negotiating Forum
 - (c) any other sectoral bargaining council designated by the PSCBC.

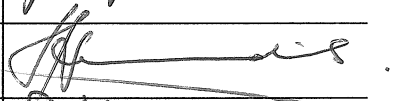
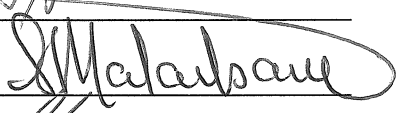
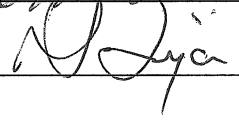
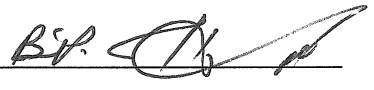
